



To Whom It May Concern:

Students participating in work-based learning such as job shadowing, internships, cooperative learning, apprenticeships, and allied health science classes being taught at Wake Tech, and a few special programs for special students are covered by insurance. This insurance is in effect if the official WBL (work-based learning) form is completed and mailed to me prior to the student going out to the work site. The coverage is \$1,000,000 for liability. This covers damage students do to the work place. There is a \$15,000 medical payment coverage. This covers the student while at the work place and while traveling to or from the work place. This would be secondary to any automotive insurance policy if the student were involved in a car accident while traveling to or from the work place. The local insurance agent is Moore & Johnson Agency. The North Carolina Department of Public Instruction arranged the insurance.
